Access by car (free car park on site): from Paris via motorway A1, from "Lille Centre", follow N356 to Roubaix-Tourcoing, leave the motorway at junction 6 "Marcq-en-Barœul- ZI La Pilaterie".
At the roundabout, take the exit on your left hand side into Boulevard Clémenceau (D48) until the Hippodrome.

Access by train : arrival at Lille Europe station or Lille Flandres station:
take the tramway towards Roubaix or Tourcoing until "Clémenceau-Hippodrome" Station,
then walk into Boulevard Clémenceau until the Hippodrome.
